Romanian citizens are one of the most commonly trafficked nationalities in Europe for both labour and sex trafficking. Statistics indicate that as many as 51% of victims of human trafficking in Romania are children.

- EDUCATE over 2,000 future and current medical professionals to identify and refer victims of human trafficking by 2025
- DELIVER community education to raise awareness and knowledge of human trafficking in 100+ communities in Romania by 2025
- CREATE dialogue and promote change on a national and international level by reaching 1,000,000+ people through campaigns and advocacy by 2025

Trainers learn about child protection, education and protective interruptive strategies for primary aged children (4-12 years). Trainers may either deliver training directly to children, or to teachers and other educators who may use the curriculum. The curriculum is provided by liberatED, along with lesson plans and activities.

VOLUNTEERING

Curriculum trainers receive specific training and ongoing support.

An induction with a volunteer coordinator will be held for successful applicants prior to the commencement of volunteering.

Volunteers report to the liberatED Board, President and Project Managers as required.

Because of the sensitive nature of some of liberatED's work, all volunteers are required to sign a confidentiality agreement before volunteering.

Any volunteers working with children will be required to provide references and a Police Check before undertaking roles as part of our safer recruitment policy.
