liberatED is a charity aimed at reducing human trafficking through education and increased community awareness.

Romanian citizens are one of the most commonly trafficked nationalities in Europe for both labour and sex trafficking. Statistics indicate that nearly 50% of victims of human trafficking in Romania are children.

liberatED's mission is to:

- EMPOWER over 5,000 at-risk children through protective education by 2025
- EDUCATE over 2,000 future and current medical professionals to identify and refer victims of human trafficking by 2025
- DELIVER community education to raise awareness and knowledge of human trafficking in 100+ communities in Romania by 2025
- CREATE dialogue and promote change on a national and international level by reaching 1,000,000+ people through campaigns and advocacy by 2025

HOW CAN I HELP?

Volunteers will use their skills, experience, and understanding of learning theories to develop age-appropriate, interactive, and engaging lessons from our child protection curriculum. Support, guidance, and training will be provided.

ESSENTIAL SKILLS AND ATTRIBUTES

- Qualification or experience in early years or primary teaching (or other relevant experience with insight into child needs, for instance: child psychologist, social worker etc.)
- Fluent in English (written and spoken).
- Demonstrable understanding in how children learn and current knowledge on educational pedagogy and practices
- Strong communication, organisational and interpersonal skills

VOLUNTEERING

Unit/Lesson plan designers receive specific training and ongoing support.

An induction with a volunteer coordinator will be held for successful applicants prior to the commencement of volunteering.

Volunteers report to the liberatED Board, President and Project Managers as required.

Because of the sensitive nature of some of liberatED's work, all volunteers are required to sign a confidentiality agreement before volunteering.

Any volunteers working with children will be required to provide references and a Police Check before undertaking roles as part of our working with vulnerable people policy.
